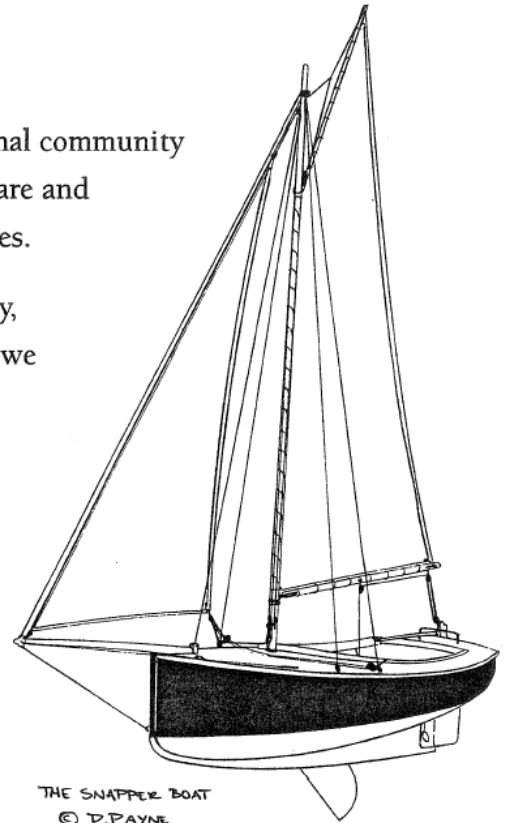

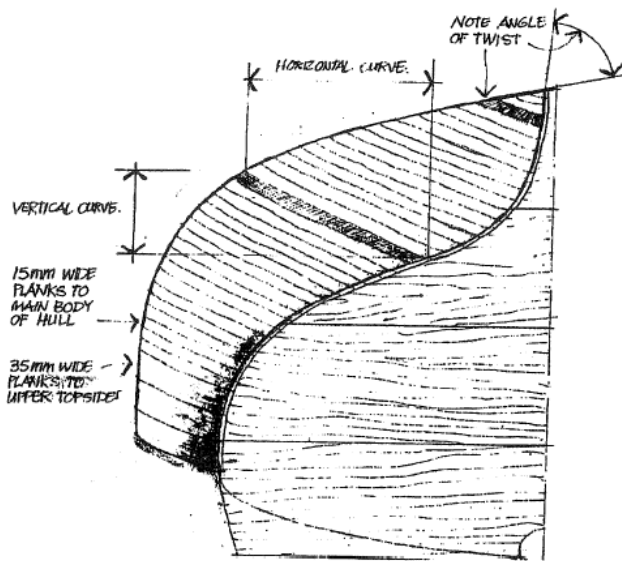

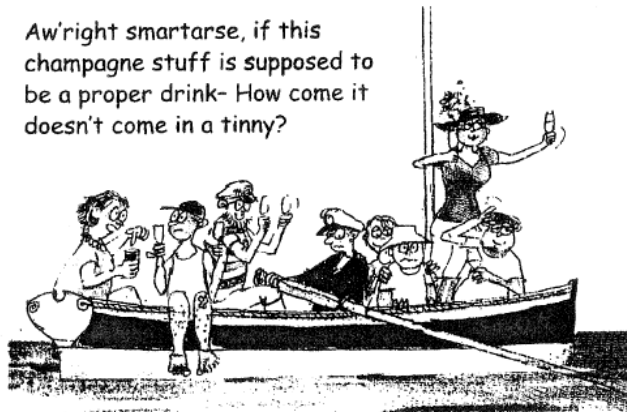
of boating in Australia and in encouraging the preservation of historic and classic boats in our waters.
